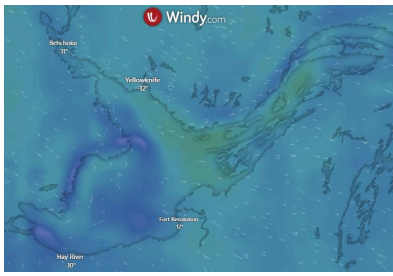




2025 Rust Remover/Recurrent Pilot Training
