CONSTITUTION

- 1. The name of the Society is Northwest Territories Flying Association.
- 2. The objects of the Society are:
 - a. to establish and promote general aviation facilities and services in the Northwest Territories;
 - b. to host flying and safety programs pertaining to general aviation operations throughout the Northwest Territories;
 - c. to engage in advocacy efforts to preserve, promote and advance interests of the general aviation community and the freedom to fly in the Northwest Territories;
 - d. to establish and promote the Northwest Territories as an "aviation friendly" environment and to support and promote aviation tourism in the Northwest Territories;
 - e. to preserve and promote the rich aviation history of the Northwest Territories; and
 - f. to serve as COPA Flight 108, being a local chapter of the Canadian Owners and Pilots Association.
- 3. The operations of the Society are to be chiefly carried on in Yellowknife, Northwest Territories.
