# PLACES TO FLY

## WILDBREAD BAY



Wildbread Bay is situated within Thaidene Nene National Park Reserve in the East Arm region of Great Slave Lake. Although floatplane access is permitted, all take-offs and landings require an aircraft access permit issued by Parks Canada. Wildbread Bay lies between McLeod Bay/ Kahochella Peninsula and Douglas Peninsula/Christie Bay.

The profiled site is a wide bay near the eastern end of Wildbread Bay and features a fine sand beach allowing for easy parking for several floatplanes. Due to the size of Wildbread Bay, the site is exposed from all directions and is best visited when winds are calm. Expansive views of Wildbread Bay and the surrounding cliffs showcase the stunning wilderness protected by Thaidene Nene National Park Reserve.

The site shows evidence of an old burn area with significant deadfall and growth of fireweed and low shrubs. Small lake trout and arctic grayling can be caught from the rocky point adjacent to the beach. This site offers exceptional camping during perfect summer conditions.
